REGISTRATION POLICY:

The Truckee-Donner Recreation and Park District is dedicated to providing you with high quality recreation services and park facilities. Our trained staff is happy to assist you in finding a class, activity or facility to meet your needs. Payment is due in full at the time of registration/or when reservation is approved.

NSF POLICY - A license number for the person signing the check must be provided. A \$25 fee will be assessed on all returned checks or credit card transactions and removed from the program.

CREDIT CARDS:

Visa, Mastercard, Discover, American Express accepted. You can fill out a credit card authorization form and fax or email it to the office.

TDRPD RESIDENT STATUS:

TDRPD Residency status is determined by proof of residency (Utility Bill, State ID, State Driver's License, Pay Stub or any legal document that says you are a TDRPD Resident) within the district boundaries (zip code 96160, 96161, 96162, 96111, 95728).

Residency status may be confirmed by contacting info@tdrpd.org.

TRUCKEE-TAHOE AIRPORT DISTRICT RESIDENCY:

Access to the Truckee Donner Community Swimming Pool: Identified by viewing a proof of residency with one of the following zip codes: 95724, 96140, 96141, 96142, 96143, 96145, 96146 and 96148.

- Allows daily admission only access to the swimming pool at residency rates only.
- This does not allow TDRPD Resident access to community pool program registration dates or rates.

Once the program month starts there are no cancellations or refunds issued for any reason.

PRESCHOOL CANCELLATION POLICY

Please note that our preschool program requires written notice 30 days prior to the beginning of the next school month if cancelling enrollment for your child's school schedule. See handbook for more information. Once the program month starts there are no cancellations or refunds issued for any reason.

CLASSES AND ACTIVITY CANCELLATION POLICY:

Participants may request to withdraw or transfer prior to the second-class meeting for TDRPD activities. All requests made after the second class will be denied, and fees will be forfeited.

All modifications for private lessons or personal training must be made 24 hours prior to the lesson or session. Any cancellations made within 24 hours of a lesson will forfeit all fees.

No refunds will be given for one-time classes, trips, tours, special events, golf activities, food services, sports leagues, passes or non-attendance of the participant.

Contract Instructor led classes or activities may have a stricter cancellation policy from TDRPD. Please reach out to the instructor or info@tdrpd.org to confirm the cancellation policy.

REFUND REQUEST POLICY:

Refunds will be issued to the original payer.

100% of fees will be credited to your TDRPD account, or a \$15.00 refund processing fee per participant per activity will be kept from registration fees, and the remainder will be refunded via original payment.

If refund via check is requested, please allow up to 4 weeks for your request to be processed.

CodeRED is an opt-in notification system, and these alerts may be received as text, email, landline, cell phone, and TTY. By joining CodeRED we will be on one platform with Nevada County creating continuity between our jurisdictions. Residents and visitors are encouraged to subscribe to CodeRED to stay informed in the event of an emergency.

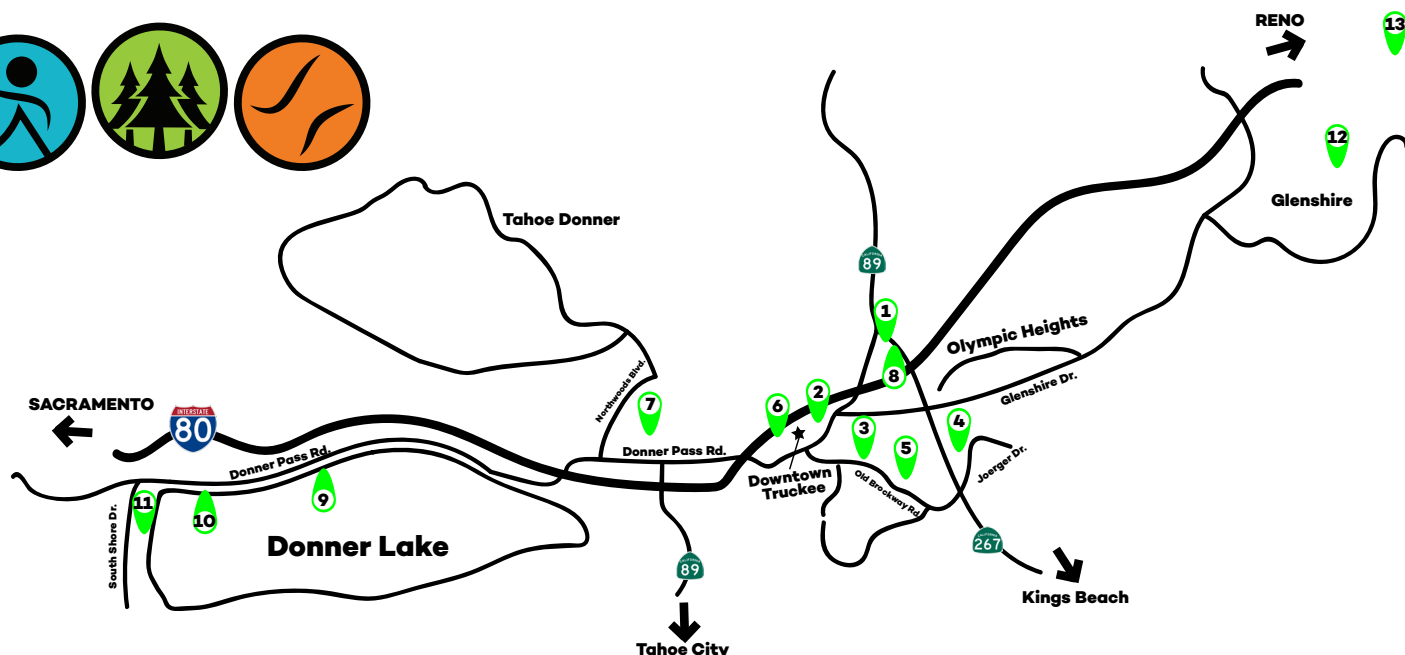

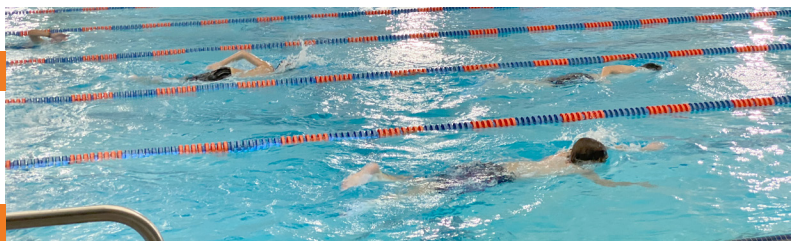

Groups over 10 people must contact aquatic coordinator prior to arrival for approval ([Email Pete](#)).

No outside food or beverage allowed in pool.

A fee is charged for all persons entering the pool regardless if they are swimming or not. The Non-Swimmer Fee is waived the last hour of every day.

*SWIM TESTING -

Children under 14 will need to pass our swimming test if they want to swim without a life vest. Test includes a 25 yard swim followed immediately by 1 minute of treading water. Testing will take place every hour on the hour.

INFANT/TODDLER - LEVEL 0

*** No "Local School" Flag required for children under 5 years old ***



Parent and Tot (4 months-3 years): We introduce basic water and safety skills and water acclimation with games, songs, & lots of toys.



Parent and Tadpole (2-3 years): Water acclimation continues in this class, where the parent and teacher encourage basic safety and swim skills through repetition and games. Child must have passed Parent & Tot or LOVE the water.



Guppy (3-4 years): This is a starting point for children with no prior experience in swim lessons. Children learn to relax & enjoy the water while acquiring swim and safety techniques.

LEVEL 1

*** No "Local School" Flag required for children under 5 years old ***



Narwhal (3-5 years): This class is for children who have passed Guppy level & feel comfortable putting their face in the water. 5-year-olds uncomfortable in the water may also take this level class. Intro to basic water safety and swim skills.

LEVEL 2

*** No "Local School" Flag required for children under 5 years old ***



Jellyfish (3-4 years): Must pass Narwhal to start. This class is for children who are 3-4 years who feel comfortable putting their face in the water. Continued intro to water safety and swimming skills.



Seahorse (5+ years): Primary Skills. This class is for children who are 5 years and up who feel comfortable putting their face in the water. Intro to water safety and swimming skills, including flutter kicks and back floating.



MSLTS (Middle School Learn to Swim): Conquer your fear of swimming! Work in your comfort zone & at your own pace to learn how to swim. Lessons taught in the shallow, warm water pool.



Teen/Adult Beginner: Conquer your fear of swimming! Work in your comfort zone & at your own pace to learn how to swim. Lessons taught in the shallow, warm water pool.

LEVEL 3



Crab: Stroke Readiness. This class is for children who can comfortably swim 5 yards on their front & 5 yards on their back. Children will continue to learn basic water safety & swim skills; front & back stroke, with introduction to treading water & deep water swimming.

LEVEL 4



Turtle: Students should be able to tread water for 10 seconds before taking this class. This class is for children who can comfortably swim 10 yards on their front and 10 yards on their back. Children will continue to develop front & back stroke, deep water swimming, with introduction to side breathing & breaststroke.

LEVEL 5



Dolphin: Lessons will take place in the lap pool. Must be able to swim 20 yards freestyle, backstroke and elementary backstroke as well as tread water for 30 seconds before taking this class. Continues water safety and swim stroke skills. Must pass lap pool swim test to move up to Level 6 Seals.

LEVEL 6



Seal: Must have passed TDRPD swim test to take this class. Students should be prepared to spend entire class in lap pool. Must be able to swim 25-yard freestyle, backstroke, sidestroke and tread water for 60 seconds.

LEVEL 7



Sea Otter: Must have passed TDRPD swim test to take this class. Must be able to tread water for 60 seconds, swim 30 yards freestyle, 25 yards breaststroke and backstroke. Develops swim fitness, water safety & refines swim skills. 45-minute class.

LEVEL 8



Sailfish: Experienced swimmers work on increased strength and endurance. Must be able to swim 50 yards freestyle, back and breaststroke. 60-minute class.
